## ABOUT US

We are a group of close friends who have known each other for over forty years.

On April 12, 2009, one of our sons was severely injured by a roadside bomb while serving with the United States Army in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Since then, we've witnessed not only Brendan's struggles, but also those of many other injured warriors as they heal their wounds and strive to regain their independence. We've witnessed not only their individual struggles, but also those of family members as they assist in their loved one's recovery.

We don't have to imagine the hardships that a family endures as it bears witness to their loved one's recovery. We've lived these hardships with Brendan. Because of our unique experiences, we know first-hand the emotional and financial challenges that these military families face as they try to restore dignity, hope and quality to their lives.

In an effort to help the injured and their families, we've established the Road Home Foundation for Injured Warriors and Families Inc., a 501 c 3 not-for-profit foundation.

## HOW WE HELP

The Road Home Foundation for Injured Warriors and Families is committed to identifying and responding to the needs of our active duty and retired military personnel and their families.

**We operate in strict adherence to four core principles:**

- Commitment to Mission
- Transparency
- Accountability
- Privacy for those we assist

**We have established initiatives in the following areas:**

- Housing
- Mobility/Transportation
- Education/Training
- Quality of Life Issues
- Referral Services



**Our initiatives are described as follows:**

### Housing

- When the need exists, provide grants to the Warrior/Veteran and/or immediate family for mortgage, rent, utilities and/or hotel expenses so that the family unit is preserved.
- Provide funding to retrofit the injured warrior's home so that he or she can live with dignity and comfort.

### Mobility/Transportation

- Provide funding to assist the injured warrior and/or immediate family members for extraordinary travel expenses.
- Provide funding for handicapped accessible vehicles for the injured warrior.
- Provide the injured veteran proper accessories/equipment for easier and safer mobility.



### Education/Training

- Provide funding to assist with living expenses while the veteran furthers his/her education.
- Provide funding to assist with the purchase of school supplies not ordinarily covered by government programs.
- Support and partner with existing training and educational programs to accelerate job and entrepreneurship opportunities for veterans.
- Provide funding and training for additional life skills training in areas such as financial management and stress reduction skills.

### Quality of Life Issues

- Provide funding for any endeavor that will improve the injured warrior's quality of life, physical and/or emotional well being or simply improve his/her morale.

### Referral Services:

- Provide assistance to the injured and his/her family in obtaining covered services from government agencies/programs.
- Provide assistance to the injured and his/her family in obtaining services from third parties that are not covered by government agencies/programs.

This may include the following:

- Housing assistance/referral
- Medical
- Legal
- Financial
